Dan Brumley Trust & Combined Abbeyfield Foundation Scholarship

Guidelines –

- To be awarded on an annual basis, for a one year period. The scholarship for 2018 will be awarded following 2018 VCE results and announced on 1st February, 2019.
- The value of the scholarship to be \$1,000.00 (comprising of \$500.00 from the Dan Brumley Trust and \$500.00 from the Abbeyfield Foundation).
- To be awarded to an eligible student (male or female) in Mortlake and district, ie. living within the surrounding area and demonstrating a tangible connection to Mortlake.
- To be awarded to a Year 11 or 12 VCE student who has completed their secondary education, to attend further tertiary education, college, university or other educational institution.
- Awarded to students based on their academic merit and proficiency relevant to the appropriate tertiary course.
- A written application a minimum of 300 words and maximum of 800 words. The application needs to include the student's connection to Mortlake, their intention for further tertiary education and ambitions for the future.
- Two references consisting one scholastic and one community.
- A copy of VCE results.
- Student to be available for interview.
- Selection by independent panel.

- The student's application will be reviewed and selected by an independent panel of the Abbeyfield Foundation.
- Student must be available for an interview between the 16th and 23rd January 2019.
- Independent panel will put forward to the Trustee for Dan Brumley Trust the nominated submission for final approval.
- The successful applicant will be notified by 1st February 2019 and announced in the local newspaper thereafter.
